

Building upgrades in the works for local schools

CONSTRUCTION company Pindan will be helping deliver better facilities for dozens of education institutions across WA with a raft of upgrades and new projects.

As part of the State Government's Building the Education Revolution program,

Pindan will construct new buildings at 34 primary schools, worth more than \$61 million, as well as carry out \$14 million of school maintenance works at 90 public schools.

Maintenance work will be carried out, among oth-

ers, at Glencoe Primary, Halls Head, Halls Head Community College, Halls Head Primary, Mandurah High, Mandurah Senior College, North Mandurah Primary, North Mandurah Education Support Centre, Ocean Road Primary, Dawesville and

South Halls Head Primary School.

New buildings will be constructed, among others, at the Career Enterprise Centre (Peel Senior Campus Site) and Halls Head Community College Education Support Centre.
